We refer to the above matter and email exchange [below](#).

As foreshadowed by the ANMF, the union and Ai Group have engaged in discussions today about the manner in which the matter ought to proceed, having regard to:

- Correspondence sent by Ai Group to chambers yesterday; and
- A decision subsequently issued by the Commission in relation to AM2017/51 Overtime for Casuals ([2020] FWCFB 4350) (**the Decision**).

Ai Group and the ANMF propose, by consent, that the directions previously issued in this matter be varied as follows:

- The ANMF is directed to file written submissions in relation to the Decision by close of business on 1 September 2020.
- Ai Group is directed to file written submissions and any evidence upon which it seeks to rely in response to the aforementioned submissions and the submissions of the ANMF previously filed in this matter, by close of business on 14 September 2020.
- The hearing on 1 September 2020 is vacated and relisted on another day not before 25 September 2020.
