#### *Expense-related allowances.*

- A. Pursuant to s 157 of the *Fair Work Act 2009*, the above award is varied as follows:
1. By deleting the amount “\$13.54” appearing in clause 19.2(a) and inserting “\$14.60”.
  2. By deleting the amount “\$13.54” appearing in clause 19.2(b) and inserting “\$14.60”.
  3. By deleting the amount “\$0.91” appearing in clause 19.7 and inserting “\$0.95”.
  4. By deleting the table appearing in clause C.2.1 and inserting the following:

<b>Allowance</b>	<b>Clause</b>	<b>\$</b>	<b>Payable</b>
Meal allowance—more than 2 hours’ overtime after usual finishing time	19.2(a)	14.60	per first and/or subsequent rest break

<b>Allowance</b>	<b>Clause</b>	<b>\$</b>	<b>Payable</b>
Meal allowance—more than 4 hours’ work on Sunday or public holiday	19.2(b)	14.60	per first and/or subsequent rest break
Vehicle allowance—using own vehicle	19.7	0.95	per km

B. This determination comes into operation on 1 July 2023. In accordance with s 165(3) of the *Fair Work Act 2009* this determination does not take effect in relation to a particular employee until the start of the employee’s first full pay period that starts on or after 1 July 2023.
