Expense-related allowances.

A. Pursuant to s 157 of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth), the above award is varied as follows:

1. By deleting the amount “\$21.58” appearing in clause 18.3(a)(i) and inserting “\$23.00”.
2. By deleting the amount “\$13.70” appearing in clause 18.3(a)(ii) and inserting “\$14.60”.
3. By deleting the amounts “\$0.96” and “\$0.32” appearing in clause 18.3(b)(i) and inserting “\$0.99” and “\$0.33” respectively.
4. By deleting the amount “\$21.75” appearing in clause 18.3(e)(i) and inserting “\$22.25”.
5. By deleting the table appearing in clause C.2.1 and inserting the following:

Allowance	Clause	\$	Payable
Meal allowance in relation to overtime—After more than 2 hours of overtime or 10 continuous hours’ work	18.3(a)(i)	23.00	per occasion
Meal allowance in relation to overtime—After a further 4 hours’ continuous overtime	18.3(a)(ii)	14.60	per occasion

Allowance	Clause	\$	Payable
Vehicle allowance—Motor vehicle	18.3(b)(i)	0.99	per km
Vehicle allowance—Motorcycle	18.3(b)(i)	0.33	per km
Tool allowance—tradespersons and apprentices	18.3(e)(i)	22.25	per week

B. This determination comes into operation on 1 July 2024. In accordance with s 165(3) of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth) this determination does not take effect in relation to a particular employee until the start of the employee’s first full pay period that starts on or after 1 July 2024.
