Expense-related allowances.

A. Pursuant to s 157 of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth), the above award is varied as follows:

1. By deleting the amount “\$24.12” appearing in clause 18.3(e) and inserting “\$24.75”.
2. By deleting the amount “\$17.27” appearing in clause 18.3(f) and inserting “\$17.72”.
3. By deleting the amount “\$42.14” appearing in clause 18.5(b)(i) and inserting “\$43.15”.
4. By deleting the amounts “\$145.18” and “\$197.68” appearing in clause 18.5(b)(ii) and inserting “\$148.67” and “\$202.43” respectively.
5. By deleting the amount “\$126.77” appearing in clause 18.5(c)(i) and inserting “\$129.81”.
6. By deleting the table appearing in clause B.2.1 and inserting the following:
