Expense-related allowances.

- A. Pursuant to s 157 of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth), the above award is varied as follows:
- 1. By deleting the amount "\$19.21" appearing in clause 17.3(a) and inserting "\$19.71".
- 2. By deleting the amount "\$19.21" appearing in clause 17.3(d)(ii) and inserting "\$19.71".
- 3. By deleting the table appearing in clause B.2.1 and inserting the following:

Meal allowance—overtime of more than 1.5 hours after usual ceasing time—without notice	17.3(a)(i)	19.71	per occasion
Meal allowance—overtime—5.5 hours or more after usual ceasing time and each further 4 hours	17.3(a)(ii)	19.71	per occasion
Travelling expenses—meal allowance while travelling to distant work	17.3(d)(ii)	19.71	per meal
Travelling expenses—accommodation when required to spend a night en route to distant work	17.3(d)(ii)	97.84	per night
