- A. Pursuant to s 157 of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth), the above award is varied as follows:
- 1. By deleting the amount "\$17.81" appearing in clause 18.3(b)(i) and inserting "\$18.27".
- 2. By deleting the amount "\$17.81" appearing in clause 18.3(l)(ii) and inserting "\$18.27".
- 3. By deleting the table appearing in clause E.2.1 and inserting the following:
