Expense-related allowances.

A. Pursuant to s 157 of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth), the above award is varied as follows:

1. By deleting the amount “\$14.25” appearing in clause 18.3(b) and inserting “\$14.62”.
2. By deleting the table appearing in clause D.2.1 and inserting the following:

Allowance	Clause	\$	Payable
Meal allowance—overtime of 2 or more hours	18.3(b)	14.62	per occasion
Tool allowance—Tradesperson (other than Carpenters)	18.3(d)(i)	15.83	per week
Tool allowance—Carpenters	18.3(d)(i)	30.88	per week
Uniform allowance—laundering—per day	18.3(e)(iii)	1.32	per day

Allowance	Clause	\$	Payable
Uniform allowance—laundering maximum per week—up to	18.3(e)(iii)	6.62	per week
Vehicle allowance—use of own vehicle	18.3(f)	0.98	per km

B. This determination comes into operation on 1 July 2025. In accordance with s 165(3) of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth) this determination does not take effect in relation to a particular employee until the start of the employee's first full pay period that starts on or after 1 July 2025.
