*Expense-related allowances.*

A. Pursuant to s 157 of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth), the above award is varied as follows:

1. By deleting the amount “\$24.29” appearing in clause 16.3(c)(i) and inserting “\$24.92”.
2. By deleting the amount “\$118.86” appearing in clause 16.3(g) and inserting “\$120.87”.
3. By deleting the amount “\$118.86” appearing in clause 16.3(g)(i) and inserting “\$120.87”.
4. By deleting the table appearing in clause B.2.1 and inserting the following:

Allowance	Clause	\$	Payable
Clothing allowance—regularly employed on work requiring attendance in evening attire	16.3(b)(iii)	300.00	minimum per annum
Meal allowance—more than one meal per day away from home	16.3(c)(i)	24.92	per meal

<b>Allowance</b>	<b>Clause</b>	<b>\$</b>	<b>Payable</b>
Spectacle allowance—maximum payment for first frames	16.3(g)	120.87	maximum for first frames

B. This determination comes into operation on 1 July 2025. In accordance with s 165(3) of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth) this determination does not take effect in relation to a particular employee until the start of the employee's first full pay period that starts on or after 1 July 2025.
