Expense-related allowances.

- A. Pursuant to s 157 of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth), the above award is varied as follows:
- 1. By deleting the amount "\$24.29" appearing in clause 16.3(c)(i) and inserting "\$24.92".
- 2. By deleting the amount "\$118.86" appearing in clause 16.3(g) and inserting "\$120.87".
- 3. By deleting the amount "\$118.86" appearing in clause 16.3(g)(i) and inserting "\$120.87".
- 4. By deleting the table appearing in clause B.2.1 and inserting the following:
