*Expense-related allowances.*

A. Pursuant to s 157 of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth), the above award is varied as follows:

1. By deleting the amounts “\$16.49” and “\$3.24” appearing in clause 19.3(a)(iii) and inserting “\$16.85” and “\$3.31” respectively.
2. By deleting the amount “\$12.85” appearing in clause 19.3(b)(i) and inserting “\$13.18”.
3. By deleting the table appearing in clause B.2.1 and inserting the following:

Laundering allowance—full-time employee	19.3(a)(iii)	16.85	per week
Laundering allowance—part-time or casual employee	19.3(a)(iii)	3.31	per shift

<b>Allowance</b>	<b>Clause</b>	<b>\$</b>	<b>Payable</b>
Meal allowance—overtime for more than 2 hours without notice	19.3(b)(i)	13.18	per occasion

B. This determination comes into operation on 1 July 2025. In accordance with s 165(3) of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth) this determination does not take effect in relation to a particular employee until the start of the employee's first full pay period that starts on or after 1 July 2025.
