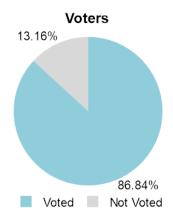

# **Ballot Report**

The following ballot report is for B2023/1153 Protected Action Ballot conducted by TrueVote on behalf of Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation. The ballot was live from 31/10/23 12:00 PM AEST to 7/11/23 4:00 PM AEST.

# Voter Roll

The voter roll for the ballot consisted of 76 registered voters. 66 voters responded to the ballot notification sent out by TrueVote.

#### Question 4

A ban or partial ban on correctly recording non-clinical data, including:

- (a) the times for "crew ready", "aircraft door close at base", "arrival at handover destination" and "patient handover date/time" in the patient journey logs on Electronic Health Records (EHR).
- (b) "Medicare Item No/Medical Chest/WorkCover details" and start and finish times on Clinic Patient Record (CPR) forms.
- (c) Aviation Flight Record (AFR) data.

- (b) between 4.08 PM and 6:00 PM immediately following a day shift, for ANMF members who work at traditional and non-traditional bases.
- (c) between 5.00 AM and 6:00 AM immediately preceding a day shift, for ANMF members who work at traditional bases.
- (d) between 5.00 PM and 6.00 PM immediately preceding a night shift, for ANMF members who work at traditional bases.

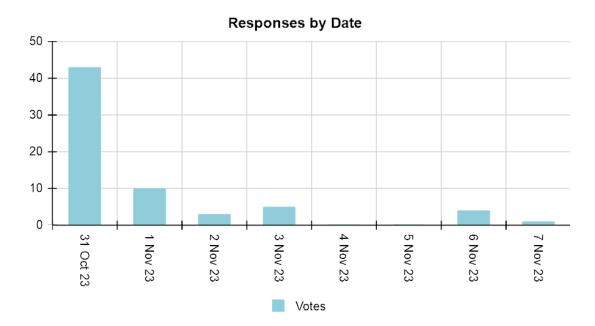
