- 20. An indefinite or periodic ban on performing work in clothes that do not have ASU branding to union campaign material attached to or displayed on it.
- 21. Interrupting or stopping work to display ASU Campaign materials in the workplace.
- 22. An indefinite or periodic ban on performing work in areas where ASU Campaign materials are not displayed.
- 23. An indefinite or periodic ban on writing emails where text is not in red font and all capitals.
- 24. An indefinite or periodic ban on reporting on the outcomes of fuel management treatments.
- 25. Interrupting or stopping work to set an automatic reply on email featuring ASU campaign slogans.
- 26. An indefinite or periodic ban on reading, replying or sending emails that do not feature ASU campaign slogans.
- 27. Interrupting or stopping work to divert all emails to CFA Workplace Relations.
- 28. An indefinite or periodic ban on reading, replying or sending emails in circumstances where emails are not being diverted to CFA Workplace Relations.
- 29. An indefinite or periodic ban on issuing charges in response to false alarms.
