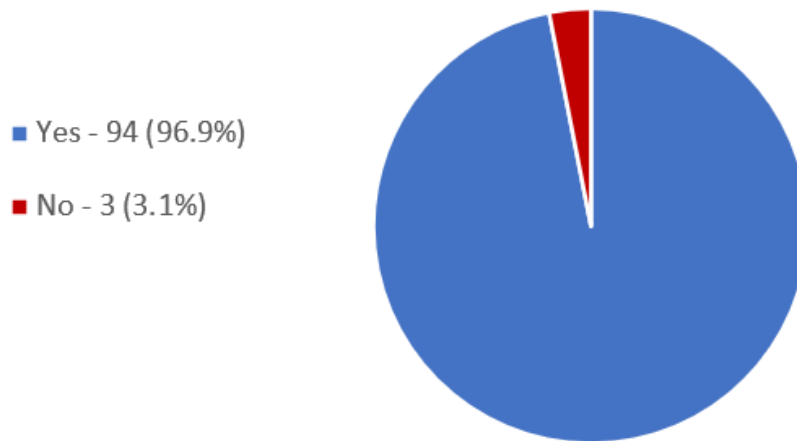

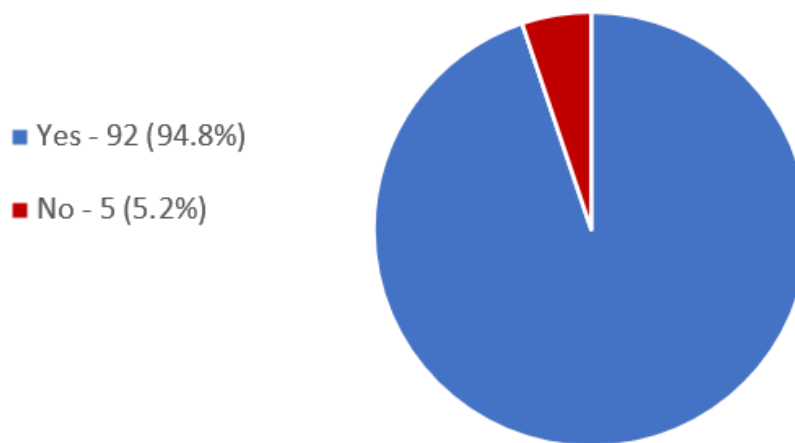

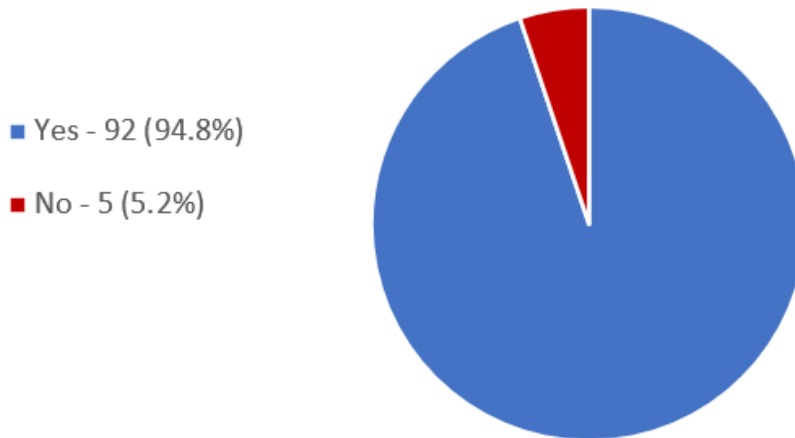

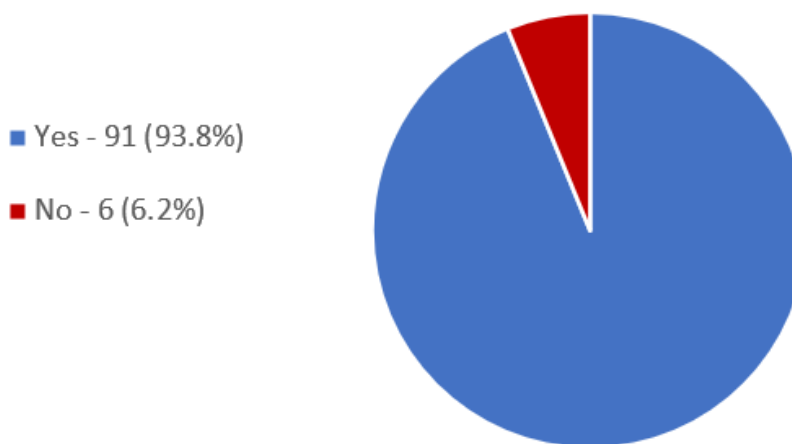

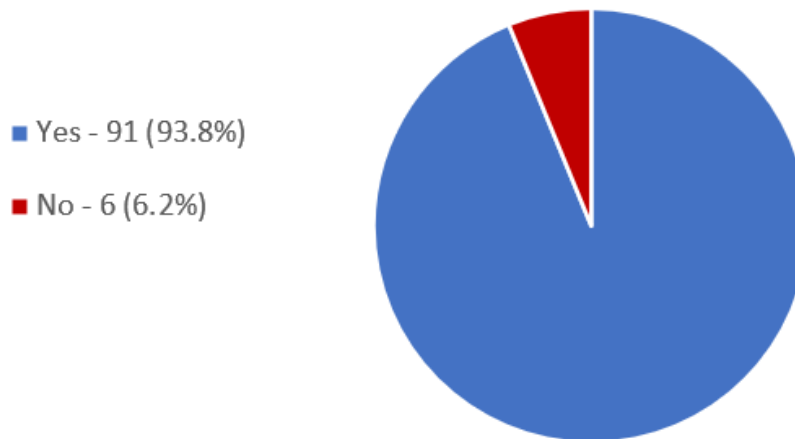

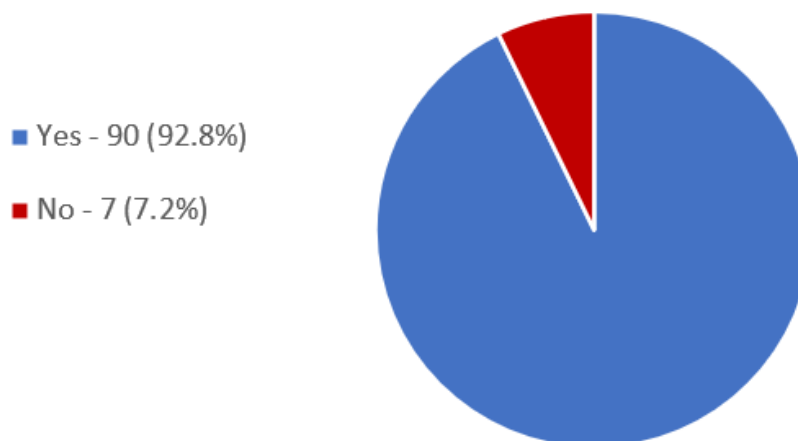

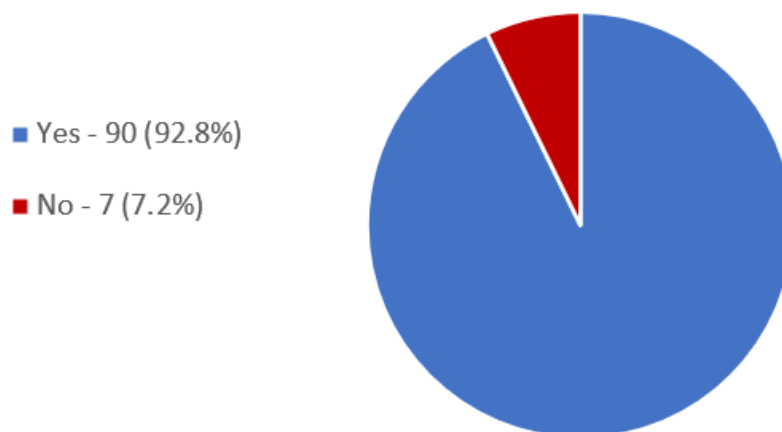

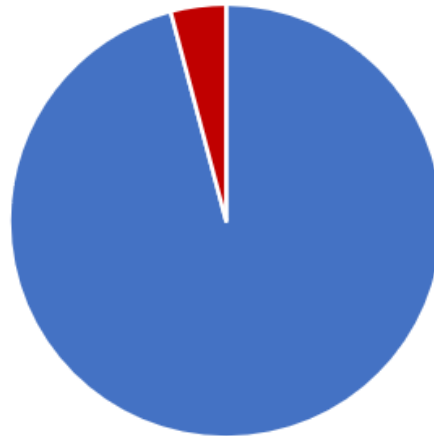

- No - 4 (4.1%)

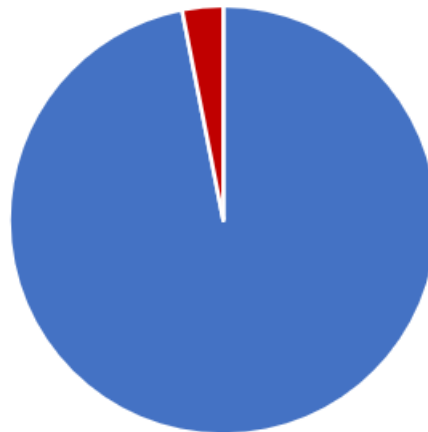


Question 16
