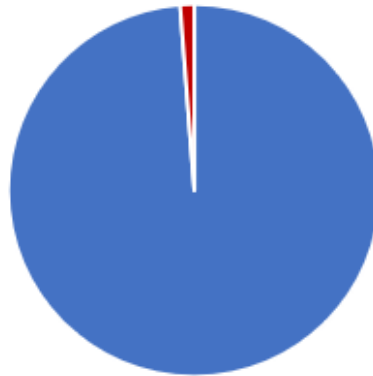

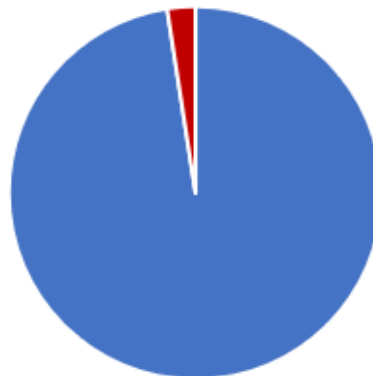

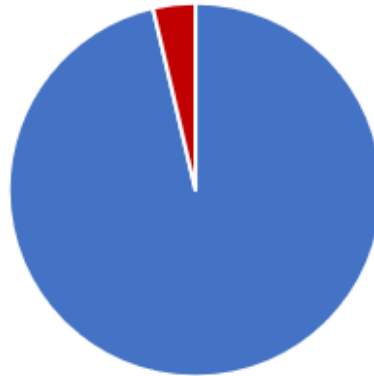

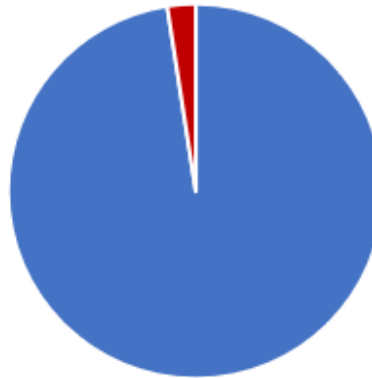

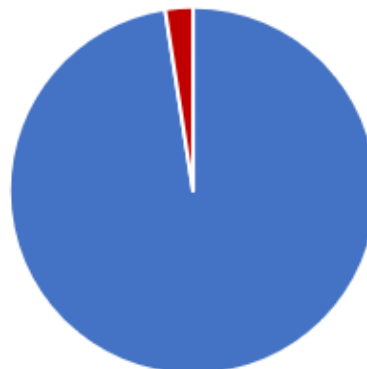

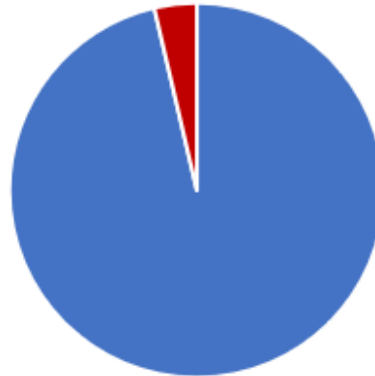

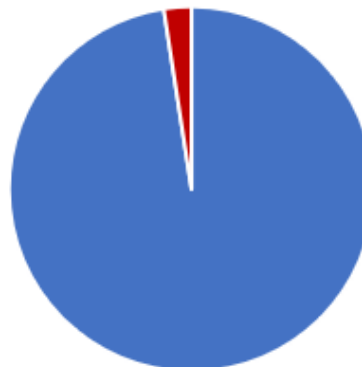

- No - 2 (2.4%)

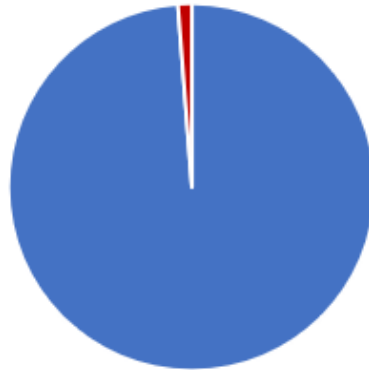

- No - 1 (1.2%)

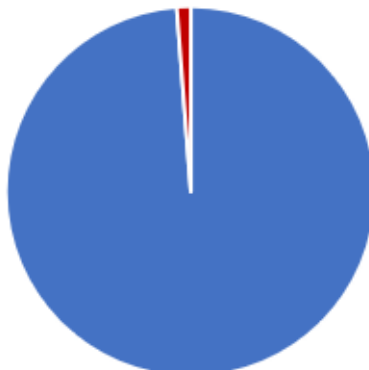
