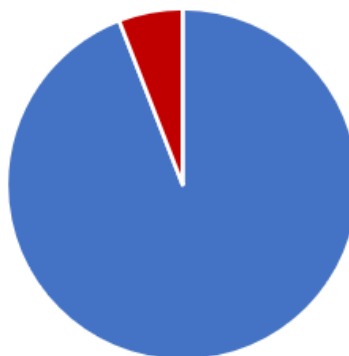

- No - 1 (5.9%)

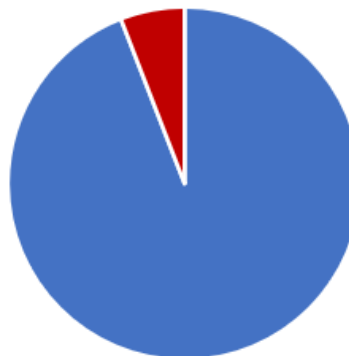


Question 2

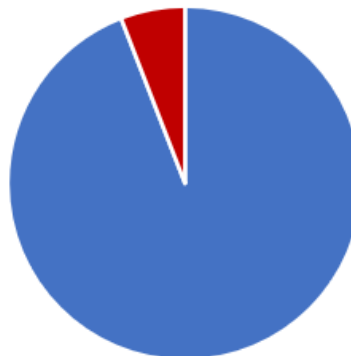

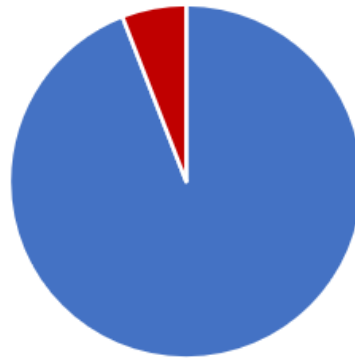

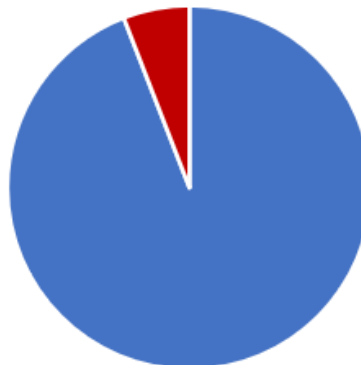
