

- -f. reviewing prisoners on Separate Confinement;
- -g. actioning prisoner transfers between correctional centres;
- -h. receiving orders into PRONTO;
- -i. performing duties for positions outside of Schedule 8 designations except on overtime;
- -j. using Corrections SharePoint;
- -k. approving or actioning Facility Maintenance fault reporting requests;
- -l. participating in core training;
- -m. having face to face contact with prisoners;
- -n. providing statistics required by management for their respective work areas
- -o. conducting audits of work areas;
- -p. performing any work in positions left vacant by Correctional Officers participating in protected industrial action;
- -q. working in areas of a correctional facility where cameras are not operational and in areas where there are no cameras;
- -r. conducting Use Of Force reviews?
