"Do you, for the purpose of advancing claims in the negotiation of an Enterprise Agreement between Edmund Rice Education Australia Flexible Schools Ltd and its employees, represented by the Union, authorise industrial action against The Corporation of Edmund Rice Education Australia Flexible Schools Ltd which may involve you and/or other employees engaging in any or all of the following forms of action, separately, concurrently and/or consecutively:
