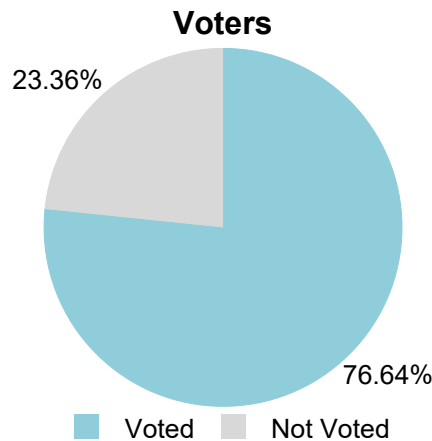

The following ballot report is for B2023/211 Protected Action Ballot conducted by TrueVote on behalf of National Tertiary Education Union NTEU. The ballot was live from 28/3/23 8:00 AM AEDT to 4/4/23 4:00 PM AEST.

Voter Roll

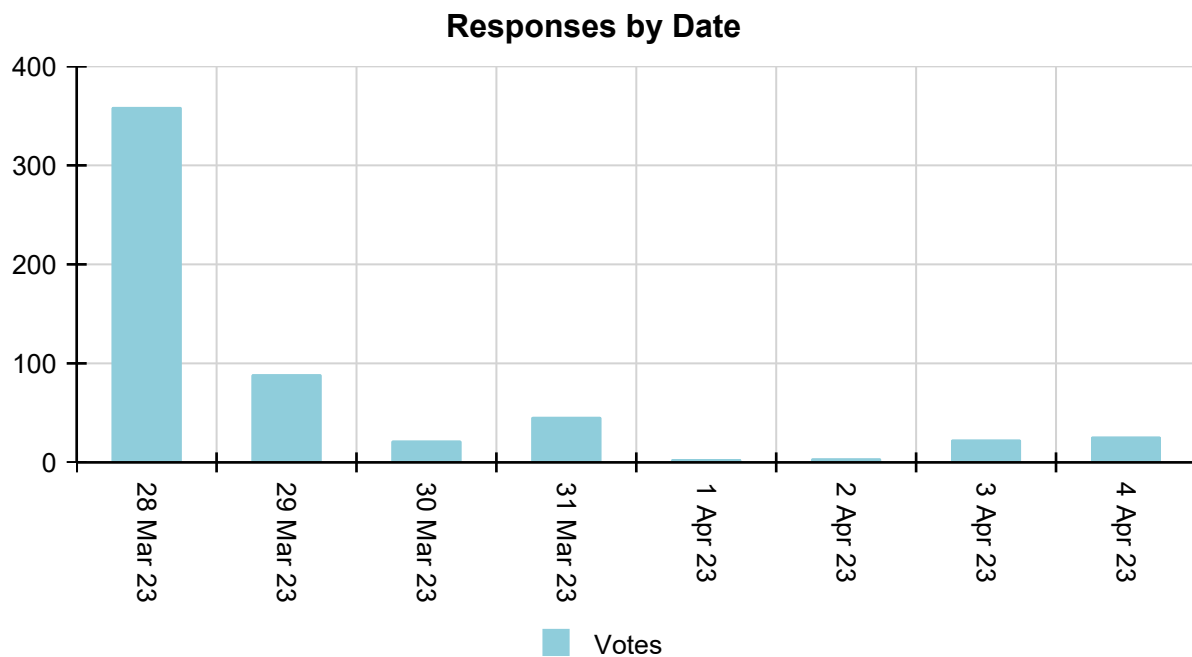
