	 Similarly, the views of the subcommittee on the priority of this application with respect to others needs to be informed by a clearer position on scope and coverage. The extent to which the application extends or otherwise applies to the bus and coach industry was discussed. The TWU identified proposed changes in the draft presented in relation to obligations of primary and secondary parties, rates reviews, prohibited provisions and dispute settlement. Further clarification and additional potential changes were discussed. More advance notice of additional draft proposals or positions were requested to facilitate more considered discussions. The TWU committed to take on board the meeting feedback and provide a further updated draft document 2 weeks prior to the 	
	 next meeting on 1 May 2025. The TWU also invited out-of-session discussions with all interested participants on areas of concern or potential areas of consensus.
