

ALPINE RESORTS AWARD 2010 – AM2016/30
FOUR YEARLY REVIEW OF MODERN AWARDS
AUSTRALIAN SKI AREAS ASSOCIATION
SUBMISSIONS REGARDING TECHNICAL/DRAFTING ISSUES

1 Introduction

- 1.1 This submission, in relation to a technical and drafting issue with the most recent exposure draft for the *Alpine Resorts Award 2016* (“**June 2017 Exposure Draft**”), is made by the Australian Ski Areas Association (“**Association**”), pursuant to President Ross’ statement, dated 9 June 2017.
- 1.2 The Association sets out below its submission in relation to the technical and drafting issues related to the June 2017 Exposure Draft.

2 Equivalency tables

- 2.1 On 15 July 2015, the Association filed submissions (“**July 2015 Submissions**”) in relation to substantive variations to the *Alpine Resorts Award 2016* (“**Award**”).
- 2.2 In those July 2015 Submissions, the Association proposed variations to the equivalency table at Schedule B of the exposure draft, due to recent name changes of certification levels by the Australian Professional Snowsports Instructors.
- 2.3 On 19 April 2016, the Fair Work Commission released a revised exposure draft for the Award, which incorporated the vast majority of the Associations suggested variations to the equivalency table at Schedule B, but which made one small drafting error.
- 2.4 In accordance with Schedule 1 of the July 2015 Submissions, in relation to the United Kingdom certification levels in Table 4 of Schedule B of the June 2017 Exposure Draft, the term “IVSI” should be inserted following “BASI (Ski Coach) Level 4 Coach”.
