Dear Associate,

I refer to the above matter and a report published by Justice Ross on 24 December 2018 regarding the same (**Report**).

Paragraphs [7] and [10] of the Report direct the Australian Industry Group (**Ai Group**) and the Australian Manufacturing Workers' Union (**AMWU**) to file a submission regarding specific issues outlined in the Report by 4pm on 18 January 2019. During a conference before His Honour on 20 December 2018, Ai Group and the AMWU agreed to have discussions prior to the filing of such a submission for the purposes of narrowing the scope of the contested issues between us.

Due to the leave arrangements of the relevant representatives of Ai Group, we will not be in a position to file a submission in accordance with the aforementioned directions. We understand that the AMWU is in a similar position.

Accordingly, with the AMWU's consent, Ai Group respectfully requests that the parties be granted an extension of time to file a submission in response to the above directions until **4pm on 29 January 2019**. We anticipate that such an extension will enable the parties to engage in productive discussions and seek instructions before filing the relevant submission.
