**4 Yearly Review of Modern Awards
Feedback on Revised Exposure Draft of the *Waste Management Award 2010*.**

On 10 October 2016, the Fair Work Commission (**the Commission**) published a decision concerning a number of Awards under review, including the *Waste Management Award 2010*¹.

On 31 October 2016 the Commission released a further revised exposure draft of the *Waste Management Award 2010* (**the October Exposure Draft**).

In accordance with the Commission's direction that the parties provide feedback in relation to the October Exposure Draft, the Australian Manufacturing Workers' Union (**AMWU**) makes the submissions that follow.

1. Part 1 – Application and Operation

Two typographical errors present:

- a) Page 4 of the Award is incorrectly labelled page "56".
- b) The words "Schedule ASchedule A" appear on the page marked "56". These words should be deleted and the words "Schedule G" inserted at the commencement of clause 1.4, and the formatting modified appropriately.

2. Clause 16 - Call-back

The following variations are necessary to clause 16 of the October Exposure Draft:

- a) Clause 16.4(b) – the reference to “clause 0” should reference “clause 16.4(a)”.
- b) Clause 16.4(d) – the reference to “clause 0 – (c)” should reference “clause 16.4(a) – (c)”.
- c) Clause 16.A should be a stand alone clause – “clause 17”. This would reflect the agreed variation that the clause be restructured to reflect clauses 30 and 31 of the current Award². This will necessitate the subsequent re-ordering of the document.

3. Further submissions filed by AiG

The Australian Industry Group (**AiG**) filed submissions on 31 August 2016 titled *General Issues arising from Exposure Drafts* and those submissions identify instances of, in their view, inconsistent terminology.

In response, the AMWU submits:

- a) Clause 15.3 should not be varied.
- b) Clause 17.2(b) should not be varied.
