I refer to recent email correspondence which seeks clarification as to the nature of the conferences before Deputy President Clancy, currently scheduled for 10 May 2016 and 23 May 2016.

The purpose of the initial conference on 10 May 2016 is to ascertain who has an interest in each of the Awards the subject of the conferences. The Deputy President intends to discuss the process for dealing with the responses to the Exposure Drafts and proposed amendments ahead of the Full Bench hearings on 6 and 7 June 2016. This will include attempting to identify which issues may be able to be dealt with by consent and which issues of a substantive nature are disputed.
