- paragraph 60 of our submission on the *Sugar Industry Award*.

The Agri-Food, Amenity Horticulture, Conservation and Land Management and Rural Production training packages are listed in the exposure drafts as separate training packages under Wage Level C. They have in fact been consolidated into one training package titled 'Agriculture, Horticulture and Conservation and Land Management'.

This is likely to be an issue that affects all modern awards.
