The HSU writes on behalf of the parties copied in this email. We understand that the Aged Care Award has been left with you for a conference concerning substantive matters to be conducted sometime after a conference in AM2014/285, [the Social Community Home Care and Disability Services Award] had been conducted by DP Booth.

The parties to the SCHCDS Award are still negotiating but conferences before DP Booth have been finalised. We are wondering if the Aged Care award could now be listed for conference in early May?
