**Submissions regarding Decision in [2018] FWCFB 1548 re technical and drafting issues in
*Broadcasting, Recorded Entertainment and Cinema Award Exposure Draft***

1. The CPSU makes these submissions in accordance with the Decision [2018] FWCFB 1548 of 21 March 2018 which determined the technical and drafting issues in the *Broadcasting, Recorded Entertainment and Cinema Award Exposure Draft*. In that decision the Full Bench asked interested parties to comment on parts of their decision and an updated exposure draft that gave effect to their decision.

Item 1 – Calculation of overtime and Item 29 – Overtime – Television Broadcasting

2. The CPSU notes the exposure draft of 23 March 2018 at clause 31 contains a note referring to the Decision about whether variations will be pursued and a track-change to include a 31.1 that refers the calculation of overtime to the minimum hourly rate. The CPSU understands this inclusion to be a claim made by Seven Network and the CPSU is opposed that inclusion. The CPSU does not believe an insertion as proposed at 31.1 is required or appropriate. Given the Decision at [242] states that overtime should be calculated at the ordinary rate, as it is currently expressed in clause 31, the CPSU supports the Decision at [274] which says such an inclusion is not necessary.
