The amendment made to clause 17.4(c) does not reflect The AWU proposal in its entirety. The amendment proposed by The AWU was as follows:

*"This equipment will remain the property of the employer and will be replaced by the employee if lost by them or destroyed through the employee's negligence, **provided that** reasonable facilities are ~~to be~~ made available by the employer for the safe keeping of such equipment."*
