RE: AM2015/230: Higher Education Industry - General Staff - Award 2010

We refer to the Directions issued by Commissioner Johns on 12 May 2016.

Commissioner Johns has requested parties file a statement to the Commission about their respective positions on outstanding issues concerning the exposure drafts for *Higher Education Industry* – *General Staff – Award 2010* and *Higher Education Industry – Academic Staff – Award 2010*.

AFEI's position of the outstanding issues concerning the *Higher Education Industry – General Staff – Award 2010* ('**the Award**') are as follows:

1. Clause 8.1 – Classifications

AFEI does not oppose the amendments to clause 8.1 as proposed by the Group of 8 Universities.

2. Clause 9.2(b)(iii) – Rostering

AFEI opposed the NTEU's submissions concerning the wording of clause 9.2(b)(iii) of the Award's Exposure Draft as previously outlined in AFEI's submissions in reply dated 9 May 2016.

The wording in the current award is clear that where an employer changes an employee's shift/roster or where an employee is transferred between rosters with less than 72 hours' notice, the employee will receive an allowance <u>instead of</u> any other shift penalty that may apply. A departure from the wording in the current Award (as proposed by the NTEU) is unnecessary and results in less clarity. Accordingly, to avoid confusion, the phrase "instead of any other shift penalty that may apply" should be retained.
