The Statement amended the directions set out in the Decision, with submissions now to be filed by **4pm Tuesday**, **30 June 2020**.

We are unsure if the extension applies to submissions on *all* matters arising from the Decision of 10 June, or just in relation to submissions on the award coverage of teachers in ECEC.
