AWU SUBMISSIONS CONCERNING THE LATEST EXPOSURE DRAFT FOR THE BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION GENERAL ON-SITE AWARD 2010

Background

- 1. On 8 October 2020, the Fair Work Commission ("**FWC**") issued a draft variation determination and tracked exposure draft in relation to the *Building* and Construction General On-site Award 2010 ("**On-site Award**").
- 2. The Australian Workers' Union ("AWU") makes the following submissions concerning the latest version of the exposure draft for the On-site Award.

Issues identified

- 3. <u>Clause 16.5(c):</u> The first sentence should relevantly read: "... that is agreed between the employer and the employee..."
- 4. <u>Clause 17.1(e)</u>: It appears the early morning shift can be added as a shift captured by this provision.
- 5. <u>Clause 18.1(a):</u> The corresponding provision in the current On-site Award, clause 35.1(a), refers to a break of "<u>no less than</u> 30 minutes". The exposure draft omits these underlined words.
- 6. <u>Clause 21.3(e)(i):</u> The words "by clause 21.3(e)" appear unnecessary and erroneous.
- 7. Clause 23.9(a): This definition is repeated in clause 2.
- 8. <u>Clause 28.5</u>: It appears the cross-reference to clause 28.1(a) should be clause 28.2. Clause 28.1(a) merely refers to superannuation legislation, it is clause 28.2 that imposes an obligation to make contributions.
