We refer to the above matter and a statement issued by the Fair Work Commission (**Commission**) on 6 May 2020. That statement required the Australian Industry Group (**Ai Group**) and the Australian Workers' Union (**AWU**) to report back to the Commission regarding an outstanding issue in respect of the *Pharmaceutical Industry Award 2010* by 4pm today.

Though there has been a preliminary exchange between Ai Group and the AWU in relation to the matter, the parties have not yet concluded their discussions. This is in large part due to Ai Group's involvement in a number of other matters before the Commission, including proceedings concerning proposed award variations in relation to the COVID-19 Pandemic.
