Thank you for your email.

We have reviewed the Statement with regard to the Local Government Industry Award Exposure Draft. We note you have referenced paragraph [154] of the Statement, however this paragraph does not refer to the Local Government Industry Award. We have assumed the reference is to paragraph [157] which lists the Local Government Industry Award 2010 in the list of Group 3 Awards where there have been no contested issues identified.

We note we are awaiting an outcome from the Full Bench regarding AM2017/51 – Overtime for casuals (the outcome of which is likely to require amendment to the Local Government Industry Award Exposure Draft) and we understand this is being treated as a separate process to AM2019/17 – Finalisation of exposure drafts. If our understanding is not correct, please let us know.

WALGA, on behalf of the Local Government Associations, does not intend to appear at the hearing tomorrow given the two proposed amendments to the Local Government Industry Award Exposure Draft are not contested and are adequately dealt with in the Statement.
