Re: AM2014/300 Award Flexibility – Maritime Awards

We refer to these proceedings and the conference which had been listed before Deputy President Kovacic on 23 March 2016.

Maritime Industry Australia Ltd (MIAL) and the Australian Mines and Metals Association (AMMA) previously made joint submissions in relation to this matter. MIAL and AMMA take the position that the model TOIL clause developed in these proceedings ought not to be included in the following modern awards:

- Marine Towage Award 2010
- Ports Harbours and Enclosed Water Vessels Award 2010
- Professional Diving Industry (Industrial) Award 2010
- Dredging Industry Award 2010

This position was reiterated at the conference before the Deputy President on 1 March 2016. MIAL and AMMA note that this position appears consistent with the views of other parties who have written to the Commission in relation to the above awards in this matter.
