C2013/633 Application by Independent Education Union for Equal Remuneration Order

We refer to the Order Requiring Production of Documents etc. to the Fair Work Commission made by Vice President Hatcher on 4 April 2018 directed to York Civil Pty Ltd ("Order").

We advise that we are today filing, with the Adelaide Registry of the Fair Work Commission:

1. an Application seeking orders to set aside or vary the Order; and
2. on the basis that the Vice President rejected York Civil Pty Ltd's request for an extension of time of the return date for the Order pending determination of its Application, documents in compliance with the Order.

We understand that a Confidentiality Order has been made with respect to the documents produced in compliance with the Order but that inspection and copying of documents produced will be permitted by lawyers for the parties.

York Civil respectfully requests that the Commission not permit any such inspection or copying to take place unless and until the Application has been heard and determined.

The documents produced by York Civil in compliance with the Order contain information which is commercially sensitive and/or confidential, including information of employees and of third parties which is commercially sensitive and/or confidential, and on that basis York Civil objects to any person inspecting the documents without further order of the Commission.
