Applications to make minimum standards orders for employee-like workers and regulated road transport contractors – President may direct the Road Transport Advisory Group as to the way it carries out its functions.

[1] Further to my statement issued on 18 October 2024 [[2024] FWC 2895] and pursuant to s 40F(5) of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth), I direct the Road Transport Advisory Group (RTAG) to provide advice as to the following matters:

Prioritisation and process for providing advice

- 1. Advice concerning how I should determine the priorities for the work of the Commission in relation to matters MS2024/1, MS2024/2 and MS2024/3.
- 2. A proposed process for the RTAG to provide advice in relation to the matter or matters it identifies as priorities, including:
  - a. a timeframe for when consultation will occur;
  - b. whether any additional entities should be served each application;
  - c. whether subcommittees will be formed; and
  - d. if so, how those subcommittees will be composed and operated. The RTAG is directed to take an inclusive and broadly-representative approach in determining the membership of any subcommittee.

## Conduct of RTAG

3. Advice on how the RTAG proposes to conduct itself more generally, including any proposed terms of reference or similar document that could form the basis for a written direction I may make pursuant to s 40F(5), taking into account the need for RTAG to be open and transparent in the way it conducts itself.
