A. Pursuant to s.157 of the *Fair Work Act 2009*, the above award is varied as follows:

1. By deleting the amount “\$14.62” appearing in clause 18.3(b)(i) and inserting “\$14.93”.
2. By deleting the amount “\$14.62” appearing in clause 18.3(l)(ii) and inserting “\$14.93”.
3. By deleting the amounts “438.19” and “438.45” appearing in clause 18.3(l)(iii) and inserting “447.03” and “447.29” respectively.
4. By deleting the table appearing in clause E.2.1 and inserting the following:
