Expense-related allowances.

- A. Pursuant to s.157 of the Fair Work Act 2009, the above award is varied as follows:
- 1. By deleting the amount "\$0.78" appearing in clause 18.3(a) and inserting "\$0.80".
- 2. By deleting the amount "\$14.93" appearing in clause 18.3(b)(i) and inserting "\$15.15".
- 3. By deleting the amount "\$14.93" appearing in clause 18.3(1)(ii) and inserting "\$15.15".
- 4. By deleting the amounts "\$447.03" and "\$447.29" appearing in clause 18.3(1)(iii) and inserting "\$466.55" and "\$466.82" respectively.
- 5. By deleting the table appearing in clause E.2.1 and inserting the following:
