Expense-related allowances.

- A. Pursuant to s.157 of the *Fair Work Act 2009*, the above award is varied as follows:
1. By deleting the amount “\$6.09” appearing in clause 18.3(a) and inserting “\$6.11”.
 2. By deleting the amount “\$17.81” appearing in clause 18.3(b)(i) and inserting “\$18.08”.
 3. By deleting the amount “\$17.81” appearing in clause 18.3(b)(ii) and inserting “\$18.08”.
 4. By deleting the amount “\$17.81” appearing in clause 18.3(b)(iii) and inserting “\$18.08”.
 5. By deleting the amount “\$10.29” appearing in clause 18.3(c)(ii) and inserting “\$10.33”.
 6. By deleting the amount “\$0.78” appearing in clause 18.3(d)(vi) and inserting “\$0.80”.
 7. By deleting the table appearing in clause C.2.1 and inserting the following:
