Expense-related allowances.

- A. Pursuant to s.157 of the Fair Work Act 2009, the above award is varied as follows:
- 1. By deleting the amount "\$0.80" appearing in clause 18.3(a) and inserting "\$0.91".
- 2. By deleting the amount "\$15.15" appearing in clause 18.3(b)(i) and inserting "\$15.50".
- 3. By deleting the amount "\$15.15" appearing in clause 18.3(1)(ii) and inserting "\$15.50".
- 4. By deleting the amounts "\$466.55" and "\$466.82" appearing in clause 18.3(l)(iii) and inserting "\$487.91" and "\$488.19" respectively.
- 5. By deleting the table appearing in clause E.2.1 and inserting the following:
