Expense-related allowances.

- A. Pursuant to s.157 of the *Fair Work Act 2009*, the above award is varied as follows:
- 1. By deleting the amount "\$13.78" wherever it appears in clause 17.3(a) and inserting "\$14.10".
- 2. By deleting the amount "\$5.43" appearing in clause 17.3(b) and inserting "\$5.67".
- 3. By deleting the amount "\$0.80" appearing in clause 17.3(e)(iii) and inserting "\$0.92".
- 4. By deleting the table appearing in clause B.2.1 and inserting the following:

| Meal allowance—overtime of more than 2 hours after normal ceasing time without notice | 17.3(a)(i) | 14.10 | per meal |
